# M.C. Honored with American Composites Manufacturers Association

## Lifetime Achievement Award



The danger of hurricanes had passed and the weather was warm and humid on Tuesday October 7th. That's when M.C. Gill found himself in front of about 2,000 people at the Tampa, Florida Convention Center. The auditorium was packed with participants of Composites 2004, the annual trade show and convention of the American Composites Manufacturers Association (AMCA). There, M.C. received a Lifetime Achievement Award – only one of these is given each year by the Association.

As M.C. was introduced and a short biography read, pictures of his early days in Terril, Iowa and move to Southern California in the 1930s was recounted. The audience learned about the beginning of the company, with more photos of the rented garage and Quonset hut used when things were getting going.

### Honored by ACMA President

"It was back in 1945 when I got myself into this jam," M.C. quipped, bringing a big laugh as Richard Morrison, President of ACMA, presented the award to him. "You've really got to stick with it when you have an idea to develop something. I figured I would accomplish my goals in ten to







fifteen years, but it took much longer than that. Persistence and being hard to discourage were the keys. Actually, in time I learned that it wasn't my vision that made things work. In reality, I eventually found I had a tiger by the tail and the market for composites appeared once the products began to prove themselves."

Composites industry professionals from all over the United States and 50 nations converged to help ACMA celebrate its silver anniversary, and to partake in what many attendees claimed was one of ACMA's best annual conventions in its 25 year history.

"It was an extraordinary showing," Richard Morrison, son of a plastics pioneer, said. "There was a very spirited and patriotic atmosphere this year that translated into lots of business deals, contact generation, and overall confidence in the future. It was great to add giving this honor to M.C. Gill to recognize his achievements and leadership in developing the composites industry."

## Composites Merit Badge Support Recognized

On stage with M.C. was Bob Booker, Executive for the San Gabriel Valley Council, Boy Scouts of America. Bob was invited by M.C. to attend the ceremony and say a few words about M.C.'s latest project, funding development of a Composites Merit Badge for the Boy Scouts. "Merit Badges are often a young man's first exposure to a particular field, and very often it peaks their interest and they make it a career. We expect the exposure a Composites Merit Badge delivers will translate into a great educational experience for these youths," Bob Booker told the audience.

It turned out that dozens of those attending were involved with the Scouts or simply interested in the project. Many came up to talk with M.C. about the project or have since been in contact asking how they can help in development of this Composites Merit Badge.
